Pure fruit driven, with a slight grassy, apple flavour, offset by zippy acidity. A classic from South Africa. Medium Dry		
<b>Semillon/Chardonay, Lazy Creek -Australia</b>		<b>£11.50</b>
A full blast of buttery vanilla oak coming through this rich wine, A good example of New World Chardonnay.		
<b>Pinot Grigio, Alba - Italy</b>		<b>£12.50</b>
Still the most popular Italian style of wine. Light easy drinking dry Fresh fruit, more depth though than most Pinot Grigio's		
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Montana, Marlborough - New Zealand</b>		<b>£16.50</b>
Marlborough being the best wine producing region for Sauvignon Blanc out of New Zealand. Medium Dry fresh young lemony fruits.
